Always use a hammer and punch to countersink nails before sanding.

IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- 1. Do not use power tools in damp or wet locations. Do not expose sander to rain. Failure to follow these instructions increases risk of electrocution.
- 2. Avoid gaseous area. Do not operate machine in explosive atmospheres in presence of flammable liquids or gases. This motor creates sparks, which could ignite fumes. Hitting a nail while sanding can cause sparks and create a fire or explosion.
- 3. Do not wear loose clothing or jewelry. Wear safety glasses, ear protection, and dust mask.
- 4. Always inspect machine for switch operation, frayed or damaged cords. Do not use if machine is not in proper working order.
- 5. Avoid accidental starting. Be sure the switch is in the "OFF" position before plugging into outlet. Do not operate without all guards in place.
- 6. Do not use machine as a step or furniture. Do not ride on this machine.
- 7. Serious damage can result if machine is left running in one spot. Always sand at a constant rate. Do not use sanders on cement. This machine is for use on wood floors only.
- 8. Never over fill dust bag or leave machine unattended with dust in bag.
 - a. Dust is extremely hot and can cause a fire. Do not empty into a combustible container.
 - b. Do not leave dust in bag upon return of the equipment to the rental yard.
 - c. For better dust pickup always empty the bag when it reaches the half full mark.
- 9. Practice first in a closet or in a less visible area of the floor.
