IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- 1. Always check that safety latches on hooks are secure. Inspect the hoist for wear or damage before each use. **Do not use a damaged hoist!**
- 2. Keep chain hoist dry.
- 3. Never stand directly under hoist or load. Do not swing a suspended load. Do not leave a suspended load unattended or in the air for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not overload. Do not lift more than rated load. Do not lower load rapidly-Always lower very slowly.
- 5. Do not wrap chain hoist around load. It is not a sling.
- 6. Do not operate with twisted or kinked chain.
- 7. Do not operate damaged or malfunctioning chain hoist.
- 8. Do not use for lifting people or loads over people.
- 9. Keep the load from hitting the load chain.
- 10. Do not jerk hanging tool.
- 11. Do not operate hoist with other than hand power.
- 12. Never use two persons to operate hand chain at once.
- 13. Do not force a chain or hook into place by hammering.
- 14. Only operate hoist if you are physically fit to do so.
- 15. Never run the load chain over a sharp edge. Use a sheave.
