Use the "buddy system" whenever you are setting up or taking down barricades. Be sure to look in the opposite direction of travel, i.e. where the traffic is coming from. Use extra caution when setting up or taking down barricades in inclement weather or when visibility may be hampered.

Always wear proper Personal Protective Equipment including, but not limited to, gloves, hi-visibility clothing and eye protection whenever setting up or taking down this equipment!

**DANGER:** This equipment has sharp edges and multiple pinch points that can cause dismemberment or death. Keep hands, feet, and all other body parts clear at all times.



## **Operation:**

The most common way to activate the flashing light attached to this barricade is by inserting a paper clip into the small hole in the battery box below the light (see arrow in photo to left.) You will feel a pressure sensitive button, by depressing it until you hear an audible click the light will either begin flashing or stop flashing.

The light on this barricade is activated by a photo sensor, therefore the light will only flash at night or when the barricade is in a dark location.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. If there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment, DO NOT USE!!! CALL A TOOL SHED IMMEDIATELY!!! FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN INJURY OR DEATH
