Due to job site or employer rules, each occupant of the platform may be required to wear personal fall protection equipment. (A Safety Harness with Lanyard attached to the Lanyard Anchorage)

IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- 1. This machine is <u>not</u> electrically insulated and <u>will not</u> provide protection from contact with electrical current. Maintain a safe distance from any power lines. (see chart below)
- 2. Never raise the platform or drive the machine while elevated unless it is on firm level surface. WARNING: This lift is for use on level concrete and asphalt slabs only!
- 3. Never sit, stand or climb on the guardrails. Both feet must always be on the platform!
- 4. Never operate the lift without first surveying the work area for surface hazards such as holes, drop offs, bumps, and debris.
- 5. Never operate the lift if all guardrails are not properly in place and secured with all fasteners properly torqued.
- 6. Secure chain across entrance after mounting platform. If equipped with a door make sure it is securely latched.
- 7. Never use ladders or scaffolding on the platform.
- 8. Never attach overhanging loads or increase platform size.
- 9. Never climb down elevating assembly with the platform elevated.
- 10. Never leave the lift unattended with the key in it.
- 11. Do not allow children to play on or around lift.
- 12. Be sure to turn key off before charging the batteries.
- 13. Batteries Need To Be Charged Daily. Check Battery Water Before Charging
- 14. Look up, down and around for overhead obstructions and electrical conductors.
