
WARNING HAND POST DRIVER

This is a simple tool, that is used to manually drive many different types of fence posts. From "T" posts, "U" posts, or any other type – as long as it fits inside the tube of the post driver.

There are 3 easy steps to follow to successfully drive a fence post with a manual post driver:

Step 1: Slide post inside of the post driver and raise both to a vertical position.

Step 2: With a good grip & comfortable stance, raise the post driver several inches off the top of the post and bring it down onto the post with force.

Step 3: Repeat, until post has been driven into the ground to the desired depth.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. If there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment, **DO NOT USE!!! CALL A TOOL SHED IMMEDIATELY!!!** FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN INJURY OR DEATH
