ACCIDENTS

Customer must report all accidents to the Rental Center no matter how minor whether you caused the accident or not and even if the accident occurred on private property.

DO NOT OVERLOAD. <<< **WARNING** >>> The maximum properly loaded carrying capacity of this truck is **26,000 LBS. GVWR.**

GVWR = Truck Weight + Load Weight + Trailer & Equipment.

The Customer is responsible for all damages and or fines incurred by overloading and these costs *ARE NOT* covered by the *Equipment Protection Plan*. Overloading could cause you to lose control of the truck, causing serious injury or death to you or others.

NOTE: The steel sideboards welded to the top of the bed *ARE NOT* to increase its capacity! They were installed to help stop debris from falling out. *DO NOT* fill the bed past the base of the sideboards.

LOAD COVERING. <<< **WARNING** >>> **California Law** requires you to cover your load. The Customer is responsible for all damages and or fines incurred by not covering their load and these costs **ARE NOT** covered by the **Equipment Protection Plan. Section 23114** (**A**) of the California Vehicle Code states: No vehicle shall be driven or moved on any highway unless the vehicle is so constructed, covered, or loaded as to prevent any of its contents or load other than clear water or feathers from live birds from dropping, sifting, leaking, blowing, spilling, or otherwise escaping from the vehicle. **The Pull Trap IS NOT Covered by the Equipment Protection Plan.**

P.T.O. <<< **WARNING** >>> Do not drive dump truck with the P.T.O. engaged. Driving with the P.T.O. engaged will destroy the hydraulic pump. The Customer is responsible for all pump damage. Pump damage *IS NOT* covered by the *Equipment Protection Plan*.

IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- 1. Check all functions before operating.
- 2. Always stay clear of bed when raising or lowering. And never get under the bed when it is raised.
- 3. Keep bystanders away while loading or dumping.
- 4. Do not dump unless truck is on solid, level ground. Avoid side hill dumping. Do not dump on hills or uneven terrain. This could cause serious injury or death as rollover may occur.
- 5. Before driving truck warm up engine to normal operating temperature.
- 6. Riders are permitted in cab only. ALWAYS WEAR YOUR SEATBELT!!
- 7. Check behind vehicle before backing up. Sound the horn when backing up.
- 8. Adjust mirrors before leaving rental yard.
- 9. Set parking brake when not in motion.
- 10. Check fluid levels daily. Check tires and tire pressure daily. The recommended pressure is embossed on the side of the tire.
- 11. Maximum speed is 55mph or less if posted. Never exceed posted truck speed limits.
- 12. Do not drive while fatigued or under influence of alcohol or drugs. Be alert!!
- 13. This truck requires a greater braking distance and when loaded even greater. Allow a safe distance between yourself and the vehicle ahead. Avoid sudden stops.
- 14. Downshift before descending a long hill. Shift to the same gear (before starting down) that would be used driving up the same hill.
- 15. NEVER get under any vehicle when it is running.

PARKING Come to a complete stop and with your foot on the brake place the gear selector into "P" (Park) position then turn wheels into curb. Engage the parking brake and turn the ignition off. **NEVER** rely on the parking brake alone and **NEVER** leave the vehicle running unattended!
